Many individuals who qualify have never heard of these benefits, so **NCP's** aim is to have a meaningful dialogue with as many atomic retirees as possible. Benefits include up to **\$400,000 tax-free** monetary compensation and **skilled in-home medical care** -- including services such as physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy and non-skilled homemaker and nursing assistance.
